6	love	S4 – the /v/ sound at the end of words
7	ears	S8 – vowel trigraph: <i>ear</i>
8	light	S8 – vowel trigraph: <i>igh</i>
9	bird	S8 – vowel digraph: <i>ir</i>
10	while	S10 – new consonant spellings <i>ph</i> and <i>wh</i>
11	well	S1 – the sound /l/ spelt <i>ll</i>
12	slower	S7 – adding <i>-er</i> to adjectives where no change is needed in the root word
13	more	S8 – vowel trigraph: <i>ore</i>
14	painted	S6 – adding the ending <i>-ed</i> to verbs where no change is needed in the root word
