5	painter	S8 – vowel digraph: <i>ai</i> S6 – adding the ending <i>–er</i> to verbs where no change is needed in the root word
6	great	S37 – common exception words
7	recent	S15 – the /s/ sound spelt c before e
8	gently	S14 – the /dʒ/ sound spelt as g in words before e S43 – the suffix –ly
9	lighthouse	S12 - compound words
10	agree	S8 – vowel digraph: ee
11	future	S44 – words with endings sounding like /tʃə/
12	worries	S23 – adding –es to nouns and verbs ending in –y
13	which	S10 – new consonant spellings <i>wh</i>
14	tunnel	S19 – the /əl/ sound spelt –el at the end of words
15	funniest	S24 – adding <i>–est</i> to a root word ending in <i>–y</i> with a consonant before it
16	written	S17 – the /r/ sound spelt <i>wr</i> at the beginning of words
17	annoy	S8 – vowel digraph: <i>oy</i>
18	national	S35 – words ending in <i>-tion</i>
19	television	S45 – endings that sound like /ʒən/
20	autumn	S8 – vowel digraph: <i>au</i> S60 – words with 'silent' letters
