| 9 | wheel | S8 – vowel digraph: <i>ee</i> S10 – new consonant spellings <i>wh</i> |
| 10 | always | S27 – the /ɔ:/ sound spelt <i>a</i> before <i>l</i> |
| 11 | slipped | S26 – adding <i>-ed</i> to words of one syllable ending in a single consonant letter after a single vowel letter |
| 12 | judge | S14 – the /dʒ/ sound spelt <i>-dge</i> at the end of words |
| 13 | improve | S4 – the /v/ sound at the end of words S37 – common exception words |
| 14 | writer | S17 – the /r/ sound spelt <i>wr</i> at the beginning of words S25 – adding the ending <i>-er</i> to words ending in <i>-e</i> with a consonant before it |
| 15 | bottle | S18 – the /əl/ sound spelt <i>-le</i> at the end of words |
| 16 | denying | S24 – adding <i>-ing</i> to a root word ending in <i>-y</i> with a consonant before it |
| 17 | cheerful | S8 – vowel digraph: <i>ee</i> S34 – the suffix <i>-ful</i> |
| 18 | forgotten | S38 – adding suffixes beginning with vowel letters to words of more than one syllable |

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| 19 | freshest | S7 – adding –est to adjectives where no change is needed in the root word |
| 20 | creature | S8 – vowel digraph: ea (/i:/) S44 – words with endings sounding like /tʃə/ |
| 21 | steak | S37 – common exception words |
| 22 | plaque | S50 – words ending with the /k/ sound spelt –que |
| 23 | scent | S51 – words with the /s/ sound spelt sc |
| 24 | playground | S8 – vowel digraphs: ay, ou S12 – compound words |
| 25 | dangerous | S46 – the suffix –ous |
| 26 | mission | S47 – endings that sound like /ʃən/, spelt –ssion |
| 27 | unique | S50 – words ending with the /k/ sound spelt –que |
| 28 | magician | S47 – endings that sound like /ʃən/, spelt –cian |
